### EXHIBIT SPACE FOR:

- \* **Original Art by Visual Artists**  
(Prints of original works acceptable)
- \* **Imported Merchandise Vendors**
- \* **Non-profit Organizations**  
(Arts organizations and organizations that provide or support multicultural resources or initiatives)



### DEADLINE: SEPTEMBER 18, 2009

### WORLD MARKET REGULATIONS:

- \* Artists, vendors & non-profit organizations **must provide** their own 10'x10' tents, tables, chairs, displays, umbrellas and decorations.
- \* Tents must be 10'x10'; **no tent stakes** in the ground are allowed. Tents must be secured with weights.
- \* For safety, security & sun protection, tents with roll down sides are recommended.
- \* No food selling is allowed in the World Market.
- \* It is permissible for World Market Vendors to sell bottled water from their booth at a cost of no more than \$1 a bottle.
- \* Due to fire codes, no tents can be linked together.

### FEE:

Each 10' x 10' tent space is \$50

*Booths and merchandise are subject to the approval of Metro Parks and Scarritt-Bennett. Vendors will be asked to remove works not approved or considered inappropriate. Vendors must be in attendance and man the booth the entire festival.*



### SETUP: Friday, October 2 • 1 PM – 5 PM or Saturday, October 3 • 7 AM – 9 AM

- \* Park Police will provide security overnight on Friday.
- \* All vendors must be set-up by 9 AM on Saturday morning.
- \* Check in for The World Market is located on the east side of the Parthenon.
- \* Vehicles are not allowed to drive on grass. Access will be through nearest paved areas. After unloading, vehicles must park in designated areas only.
- \* Parked vehicles must be moved on Sat. by 9 AM.



### BREAK-DOWN:

- \* Booths, tents, etc. may not be disassembled **until 6 PM on Saturday.**
- \* Exhibit spaces must be left free of litter.
